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Dear Import Permit Holder:

Your request for a waiver from the Certificate of Label Approval (COLA) requirement is approved. This approval is conditioned upon your compliance with **ALL** of the following conditions:

- a. All applicable taxes and duties are paid on the imported products. (Please note that this waiver does not in any way relieve your burden from the obligation to comply with any applicable State taxes or requirements.)
- b. Each individual container bears a label stating "Sample Only – Not for Sale", or a similar such phrase displayed in a conspicuous manner.
- c. Each individual container bears a label with the following health warning statement mandated by law:
GOVERNMENT WARNING: (1) According to the Surgeon General, women should not drink alcoholic beverages during pregnancy because of the risk of birth defects. (2) Consumption of alcoholic beverages impairs your ability to drive a car or operate machinery, and may cause health problems.
- d. If wine, each individual container bears a label stating: "Contains Sulfites".
- e. Any samples remaining at the conclusion of the sales solicitation period or trade show event must be destroyed or returned to the foreign supplier.
- f. The products approved under this waiver comply with the minimum labeling requirements above prior to arrival at the U.S. port of entry.

Furthermore, please note that it is your responsibility as an importer to ensure that any products imported pursuant to this waiver remain in your possession and do not enter into interstate commerce without an approved COLA. Alcohol beverages that will be served to the general public or distributed as gifts may only be imported pursuant to an approved COLA. Non-compliance with the cited requirements may result in action against your Importer's Basic Permit, or other administrative actions.
