



2013 Pinot Noir Dierberg Vineyard Santa Maria Valley AVA

Planted in 1997, the Dierberg Vineyard is located in the middle of the Santa Maria Valley and boasts 161 acres of rolling hills of mostly sandy loam soils. About 2/3 of the vineyard is planted to Pinot Noir. We have enjoyed working with the Dierberg family, vineyard managers and fruit from this vineyard since the first crop in 2001. After a few years of not sourcing fruit from Dierberg Vineyard, our fans are happy to have this vineyard back in our portfolio and we are too!

Tasting Notes

Enjoy leather, cola and spice, along with candied apples, black cherries and plum on the nose. This full bodied wine also shows black cherry and cola on the palate, which is enhanced by a nice balance of toasted oak and fruit tannins. Pair with big fat juicy BBQ ribs, scallops wrapped with bacon, apple sausage or dark chocolate. This wine will benefit from aging. One of our favorites in the library is the 2001 Dierberg!
